TOUR INFORMATION

Small Group Tours

Leisure Options believes in creating memorable experiences for each of our travellers. We prefer to travel with smaller groups (normally up to 12 people including staff) which enable us to provide personalised and bespoke travel experiences.

Limited numbers, with high staffing ratios, allows us to customise every tour and include activities and outings that stimulate each of our traveller's interests. These shared interests and experiences lead to more meaningful friendships and long-lasting memories.

Tour Leaders

Leisure Option's tour leaders focus on delivering incredible service and an authentic experience to make each holiday memorable. By building strong relationships with each traveller our tour leaders strive to understand individual needs and provide support in a safe and nurturing environment. Their unique knowledge of the destinations we visit ensures that you can relax and immerse yourself in a physical, emotional and cultural journey. Our tour leaders all have police checks, NDIS Worker Screening Checks, first aid certificates, COVID vaccinations and access to 24 hour nursing advice and support. Tour leaders are not able to share rooms with travellers but will be available when needed.

High Staff to Traveller Ratios

At Leisure Options we strive to offer unparalleled holiday support, guidance and care. To enable this our holidays are always staffed at high support ratios. Offering ratios no greater than 1:4 ensures that you are able to actively participate in holidays that meet your aspirations and goals. Leisure Options staffing ratios are the highest in the industry and provide peace of mind that you will receive the care and support you require.

Accommodation

Leisure Options aims to create a family like atmosphere whilst on tour. To do this, where possible we stay in luxury houses with multiple bedrooms so that everyone is accommodated under the one roof. This provides the greatest opportunities for travellers to socialise and create meaningful friendships. On cruises we only use twin share cabins and when booking hotels we aim for 4 and 5 star luxury accommodation. We can also arrange a single room for travellers, however a single supplement will apply.

Active Night

Leisure Options is happy to provide checking or intervention during the night (for example, due to a medical condition such as epilepsy). This will require an active night staff person be rostered during your holiday and must be organised prior to departure. Leisure Options will arrange for active night support as part of planning your holiday. As not all travellers require this support these costs are not included in the advertised prices of the holidays.

Airfares

Airfares are NOT included in the advertised price of the holiday except where indicated. We encourage travellers to book holidays early so that we can negotiate the best possible airfares on your behalf. Leisure Options pays for carbon offset on airfares to assist with greenhouse gas emission reduction.

Departures

All advertised holidays depart from Melbourne. However, if you live elsewhere, we are able to arrange for you to join the holiday on route or have a tour leader travel with you from your location to our departure point. There will be an additional cost for this service.

Pre/Post Tour Accommodation Package

If you need an additional night of accommodation before or after your holiday, we can arrange this for you at a cost from \$865 per night. This includes staff support from 4:30 pm on the day prior/post travel through to your departure, dinner, bed and breakfast.

Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is not included in the price of your holiday but we strongly recommend all travellers obtain insurance. Travel insurance is mandatory for all cruises and international holidays.

NDIS

Leisure Options is a nationally registered NDIS service provider. Our tours offer opportunities to develop new skills and capabilities in a safe and fun environment.



HOLIDAY RATIOS

All Leisure Options holidays are tailored to provide you with the greatest enjoyment. To ensure we can cater for your needs and deliver safe experiences, we have developed holiday ratios to provide you with the appropriate level of care. The ratios indicate the number of staff members on a holiday for each traveller. Select your care requirements to determine your holiday ratio – if you have care requirements across multiple ratios you will travel as your lowest ratio to allow Leisure Options to provide you with the safest level of support.

1:4/1:3 Ratio

For travellers who are primarily independent in all areas of personal care and meals and have appropriate social skills when out in the community.

Living Situation

- living independently in supported accommodation or with family members

Personal Care

- independent with all activities of daily living including showering, shaving, toileting or brushing teeth
- requires a minimal amount of prompting with personal hygiene (such as help adjusting shower temperature or choosing appropriate clothes)

Meals

- able to eat independently and appropriately and capable of preparing beverages
- is confident in a restaurant and other public places
- requires minimal assistance to select meals or cutting of food

Money

- can manage their spending money with minimal assistance

Behaviour

- has good social skills in the community
- understands road rules and can stay with the group on outings
- able to handle a full day of activities in the community and can follow instructions
- no behavioural issues or challenging social conduct

1:2 Ratio

For travellers who require greater assistance with personal care and meals, those that use mobility aids or enjoy slower paced travel and those needing close supervision when out in the community.

Living Situation

- living in supported accommodation or with family members

Personal Care

- requires some assistance with activities of daily living including showering, shaving, toileting or brushing teeth
- requires prompting to select appropriate clothes and some assistance with dressing
- may use continence aids

Meals

- requires assistance during mealtimes and supervision to eat appropriately
- needs assistance when dining in restaurants and in public
- needs observation when eating and drinking due to mild dysphagia and may have a mealtime management plan

Money

- requires support in handling of spending money

Behaviour

- requires closer supervision in the community and on outings
- needs prompting to stay with the group
- displays some mild behaviours of concern

1:1 Ratio

Travellers who require full assistance with personal care, meals and require supervision in the community. This also includes travellers in manual or electric wheelchairs who are able to transfer independently or with guidance.

Living Situation

- living in supported accommodation or with family members

Personal Care

- requires full assistance with activities of daily living including showering, shaving, toileting or brushing teeth
- requires assistance with dressing, choosing clothes
- may use continence aids and requires assistance to change

Meals

- has special requirements during mealtimes and needs assistance to eat such as being fed by staff
- needs meals to be cut up or modified and will likely have a mealtime management plan
- requires full assistance and constant supervision when dining in restaurants
- has mild to moderate dysphagia not exceeding Level 2 for liquids and Level 5 for food. Anything beyond these levels, Leisure Options cannot support

Money

- requires full support in handling of spending money

Behaviour

- requires full assistance and supervision in the community and on outings
- can display some mild behaviours of concern

HOLIDAY CATEGORIES

Leisure Options tailors a wide range of holidays for people with different interests, skills and abilities. Our holidays are categorised to help you choose the most suitable option for your capability and needs.

Independent

- Travellers with good social and communication skills
- Independent in personal care and activities of daily living
- Have good mobility and can eat independently in restaurants
- Understands and follows directions
- Can stay with the group on outings, or meet back with the group at specified time and venue

Active

- Travellers that can cope with a faster paced holiday
- Safely manage all forms of public transport
- Manage days with a substantial amount of walking
- Good fitness level and meets the independent criteria

Extra Assistance Personal Care

- Travellers who require assistance with showering, toileting, other areas of personal care, meals and activities of daily living

Extra Assistance Mobility

- Travellers who require extra assistance with walking or uses a mobility aid such as a walking frame or wheelchair for distance
- Can manage a regular bus or coach or a few stairs

Physical Disability

- Travellers who requires a wheelchair or walking frame for mobility along with accessible accommodation, facilities and transport

Respite supports people with disabilities and their families by giving carers short breaks from their caring responsibilities. It also offers participants an alternative to their daily routine or usual living situation and the opportunity to try new things.

Leisure Options Respite Care supports you in a relaxing, safe and nurturing environment, while your loved ones enjoy a break as well. We believe that respite should be a positive experience for both you and your carer, providing beneficial and meaningful new experiences that leave you both refreshed and invigorated.

Programs take place at the company's Anglesea property and other select locations. In many cases we can provide Respite options at a destination or location of your choice.

Whether you come for a night or a week our team work to diligently prepare daily activity plans that meet your needs, interests, and desires. Activities are tailored to each individual and may include a mix of gardening, cooking, arts, and crafts, games, puzzles, nature walks, beach visits, attractions, and any other interests you may have. Respite programs can be as active or relaxed as you wish.



How is Respite Funded?

Respite care can be included as part of your NDIS plan. The NDIS will fund short term accommodation if the need is related to your disability, it will help you pursue your goals and it will help you participate in the community. Leisure Options believes that time spent utilising respite is a powerful tool in strengthening your independence, life skills, and community access experiences.

Under the NDIS, Short Term Accommodation is funded under Core Supports in your NDIS plan.
